#### Graduation Rates

A Graduation rate is not calculated if there are not at least 10 students in the graduating

81.7% of students graduated in 4 years

84.5% of students graduated in 5 years

79.8% of students graduated in 6 years

79.4% of students graduated in 7 years

67.0% of students graduated in 8 years

81.7% is the weighted average of all graduation rates.



The 4-year graduation rate applies to the Class of 2018 who graduated within four years, i.e. students who entered the 9th grade in the fall of 2014 and graduated by the summer of 2018.

Does Not Meet= 0.0 - 7.9%


### 5-Year Graduation Rate

# **Gap Closing**

The Gap Closing component shows how well schools are meeting the performance expectations for our most vulnerable populations of students in English language arts, math, and graduation. It also measures how schools are doing in helping English learners to become proficient in English.

### **Annual Measurable Objectives**

Annual Measurable Objectives (AMOs) compare the performance of each student group to the expected performance goals for that group to determine if gaps exist. These charts show how well each group compares to the state average in ELA, math and graduation. A fourth AMO measures whether English Learners are making progress towards becoming proficient in English. The ultimate goal is for all groups to achieve at high levels.



### 6-Year Graduation Rate

The 6-year graduation rate applies to the Class of 2016 who graduated within six years, i.e. students who entered the 9th grade in the fall of 2012 and graduated by the summer of 2018.



### 7-Year Graduation Rate

The 7-year graduation rate applies to the Class of 2015 who graduated within seven years, i.e. students who entered the 9th grade in the fall of 2011 and graduated by the summer of 2018.



### 8-Year Graduation Rate

The 8-year graduation rate applies to the Class of 2014 who graduated within eight years, i.e. students who entered the 9th grade in the fall of 2010 and graduated by the summer of 2018.



### **Combined Graduation Rate**

This combined graduation rate is the weighted average of 4- through 8-year graduation rates.
