# **Discussion Items:**

- Enrollment Numbers Currently we have 145 active students. 25% of our students are from the county with 75% of our students being from Findlay. Our county students' numbers are as follows: VB -7; CR 5; LB 3; Arc 4; Mc 4; Riverdale 4.
- Millstream /CCP Numbers We currently have 6 junior and 6 seniors enrolled in Millstream. We currently have 3 students this Fall and 6 students signed up for Spring.
- Credentialing Programs Rosemary shared that we have had meetings with Lou Cook and Lynn Child to look into developing a short-term credentialing programs for our students at FDA as well as Hancock County. These meetings included Dream Center Support and Information, Northwest State Community College representatives, credentialing programs, and support services such as the City Mission and Jobs and Family Services.
- CCIP/OIP Rosemary shared with the Board that we are working closely with our school treasurer in respect to the expenditures of our Federal Programs dollars.
- Update on 22+ Program We currently have 20 students in the 22+ Program with more applications being processed.
- Update on the Resource Coordinator/Guidance Counselor Rosemary shared that
  Maria has been very busy putting out a staff survey, a student survey, creating a
  sling bag filled with community resource information, doing individual student
  counseling, and wellness planning. Our students are benefiting from this
  additional position.
- Update on FDA management system We are working with a company named Main Springs to help us try to organize and develop our nearly antiquated FileMaker program to try to make it work and communicate with DASL, the State reporting management system.
- COVID Update Michael shared the latest data from the weekly Wednesday meetings with the Hancock Health Department. Masks are continuing to be stressed but are not required. Hancock County continues to be in the "Red" High Infection Level.
- Upcoming EOC Tests These tests will begin at the start of December. We will begin interventions in November with those students we have "targeted" as needing focus support. We will also offer "Test Prep" to help students prepare and better understand the tests.
